Bible study questions and application

1. Introduce the study by asking the group to analyse the decision-making process; include in your analysis the reality of options, preferences, likes, dislikes, conclusions.
2. Is it true that the choices we make flow from the desires we have with the strongest desire leading the way?
3. Review the temptation facing the Hebrew Christians that Judaism with the presence of angels was more appealing to them compared to the suffering they were having to endure as Christians.
4. What temptations do we face today as more appealing than pursuing a life of faith in Christ? In the sermon 3 were mentioned (Another religion, another way of life and another gospel – explore examples in each of these categories)
5. The writer to the Hebrews shows that Jesus is better than the rest by quoting 7 passages from the OT – giving 4 reasons why Jesus is best. Discuss each of these:
 - a. Jesus has a unique relationship
 - b. Jesus has a unique status
 - c. Jesus has a unique nature
 - d. Jesus has a unique position
6. Read Hebrews chapter 2:1-4 discussing and applying the warning, consequences of drifting.
7. What can we do as Christians day by day not to end up falling away from our faith by neglect?
8. Pray for each other to stand firm in the faith and for those known to the group who have fallen from faith in Christ.
