Bible study questions and application

1. Ask the group to discuss the meaning of discipleship and then compare what they have suggested with Luke 9:23
2. How can we be like Peter having a self-confident approach to discipleship as seen in John 13:37 and Luke 22:31?
3. Discuss Proverbs 16:18 giving examples or citing instances where the so called "mighty have fallen". King David committing adultery with Bathsheba is an example from the Bible.
4. Why is it so hard for us to be challenged by someone asking hard questions as Jesus did to Peter?
5. Consider the questions from Jesus to Peter and his responses to Jesus and how they apply to us today in our ministries.
6. What role does our love for Jesus have in our daily and weekly ministry?
7. What is revealed about the nature of Jesus from our passage? (Omniscience, redemptive purposes, compassion and His commitment to human instrumentality are some of them)
8. What can we all do to grow in our love for Jesus?
