Bible study questions and application

1. Read Psalm 100 and review the structure with the group identifying the 7 imperatives.
2. Discuss each of the imperatives with regard to how they apply to us in our Sunday services.
3. In the sermon 4 different points were made regarding signals that worshippers send to each other and to God. Discuss each one of these signals as they apply to us when we are at church and also when we out in the world.
 - a. An undeniable focus
 - b. An obvious exuberance
 - c. An attitude of gratitude
 - d. An expansive vision
4. How can we encourage one another to grow as true worshippers of God?
5. Discuss Jesus' comment... *John 4:23 But the hour is coming, and is now here, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for the Father is seeking such people to worship him. 24 God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in spirit and truth.*
6. What gets in the way of God glorifying worship?
7. Why does worship matter?
8. Bob Kauflin writes in his book "Worship Matters" that your heart and mind is important in true worship. your heart exposes what you love and your mind exposes what you believe. Do you agree giving reasons for your answer.
