

Psalm 100 (Part 2)
Bible study questions and application

Serve the Lord with gladness

1. Review the call to worship in Psalm 100 by pointing out the 7 imperatives in the Psalm.
2. The commands are not given in isolation. The theme of the sermons was to identify what we need to know in order to do what God calls to do in worship
3. Discuss the points from the sermon:
 - a. Knowing that the Lord is God and that He exists
 - b. Knowing what God is like as creator (creation and redemption) and that He is uniquely good.
 - c. Differentiate between the goodness we see in some people and the goodness of God. Refer to some passages from the Bible.
4. Allow for some discussion about the place of feelings in our worship.
5. In the sermon it was said that this Psalm of praise teaches the crucial truth that worship is not an overflow of experience but **an expression of faith** referring to *Romans 10:17 so faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ*. Do you agree or disagree, why?
6. Discuss the crucial connection between the call to worship and knowing certain things.
7. In what practical ways can we grow in our worship of God?
8. Pray for each other.
