

Psalm 8 Bible study questions and application

1. Psalm 8 (a Messianic Psalm) is a beautiful worshipful hymn of delight revealing mind blowing truth about God, creation and man. Review the truths revealed in this Psalm under the headings used in the sermon...
 - a. The Superior greatness of God
 - b. God does not need a reference
 - c. The surprising concern God has for dust
 - d. God has given man a privileged position
 - e. God's loving provision (take note how the NT authors interpret this Psalm as pointing to Jesus)
2. Explain some of the theology (using R C Sproul – Essential truths of the Christian faith) evident in this Psalm:
 - a. the incomprehensibility of God (p31)
 - b. the self-existence of God (37)
 - c. human beings created in the image of God (p131)
 - d. the sinlessness of Christ (p83)
 - e. Jesus the Mediator (p99).
3. Is it possible that we sometimes become dull in our faith being taking for granted the radical nature of what this Psalm reveals about God and us?
4. If we really believe this truth what should our response to God be?
5. If we really believe this truth what should our response to other people be?
6. What changes ought to take place in your life in the light of this Psalm?
