Operation Mobilisation, Ecuador

After finishing high school, Darren got involved in Central's Evangelism Explosion ministry, and discovered a passion for the gospel and personal evangelism.

In 2002 Darren spent three months in Paraguay with SIM, followed by nine months there in 2004. He learned some Spanish and worked with a church in rural Caazapa helping to train their worship team. He also gave music lessons to non-Christians as a means of outreach. Through these experiences he discovered a heart for South America and a burden for Catholics. After his return to South Africa, God confirmed His call to be a full-time missionary to South America, more specifically to Ecuador.

In January 2007, Darren joined OM's six-month training programme, which included personal spiritual development, ministry training and outreaches to Mozambique, Muslims and Hindus in Durban, and street people in Pretoria.

In September 2007 he moved to Guayaquil, Ecuador, where he is the Evangelism Coordinator for OM. He is involved in coordinating OM's evangelistic ministry, evangelism workshops with churches, assembling and developing evangelistic materials, generating evangelistic projects, and church planting on Santay Island.
